1. Treasurer's report

- Wayne reports balance of \$64,565.78 in checking account and \$4,900 in Equipment Replacement account
- Argo payment—Wayne explained that in order to pay for the Argo, we will use our line
 of credit. When funds come from the state, LDFLA and Keewaydin, we will use those
 funds (approximately \$26,000) to pay down the line of credit and finance the remainder
 through our current mortgage.
- Wayne is investigating new carriers for liability and D&O insurance policies

2. Larvicide Report

- Dry conditions mean very low larvae counts which, in turn, means only a very limited amount of larvicide has been applied
- Will Mathis has been monitoring the adult mosquito population using CDC light traps
- 3. Ben is discussing the possibility of having the new Argo vehicle enter into the Brandon 4th of July parade
- 4. Ben Lawton, speaking on behalf of the Board, expressed his gratitude to the LDFLA and Keewaydin for their donations to help purchase the Argo.
