## **BLSG Mosquito Control Board – Minutes 11/10/15**

Ben Lawton called meeting to order at 7:28 p.m.

1. Treasurer's Report-- Wayne Rausenberger

- General Checking account has a balance of \$48,026
- Equipment Replacement and Capital Improvements Fund has a balance of \$400.28
- Wayne sent bill of \$15,073 to town of Salisbury for the 2015-2016 assessment
- Wayne expects a check in the amount of \$7,375 from town of Brandon this week
- It was noted that the per day rate (85 cents) was the most economical way for renting airgas tanks for light traps.
- 2. Report on work with the Town of Pittsford- Will Mathis
  - Will has one more area to survey and then the Pittsford map will be complete.
  - Will will create a spreadsheet of relevant data and information for Pittsford.
  - We discussed the possibility of Pittsford joining the BLSG or contracting out to the BLSG.
- 3. Proposal to Amend the By-Laws
  - Wayne has proposed amending the By-Laws such that the necessary quorum to conduct BLSG business would be reduced from five to three. Lacking the necessary quorum to amend the By-Laws (6 of 8 members), the proposal was tabled (Moved by Ben Lawton, 2<sup>nd</sup>: Jeff Whiting).
- 4. BLSG Budget for 2016
  - Wayne Rausenberger presented the budget proposal for 2016 of \$78,350, which represents a \$8,950 increase for 2015, \$5,000 to go to Equipment Replacement, Capital Improvement Line Item.
  - The motion to pass the 2016 Budget passed (moved: Pete Hare, 2<sup>nd</sup>: Jeremy MacLachlan).
- 5. Year-End Reports
  - Will Mathis (Larvicide) will submit a Larvicide Report to Ben Lawton by December 15.
  - Mort Pierppont will submit an Adulticide Report to Ben Lawton by December 15.
  - Mort reported that the 2015 season has officially ended and that he has winterized all BLSG equipment for long term storage
  - Work that Mort will do this winter includes: downloading GPS information, moving hand-held radios to warm storage, reporting usage to State for all applicators, taking inventory, and meeting with landowners to establish "no spray" zones.
- 6. Election of Officers for 2016

- Board Action: Checks exceeding \$500 in the BLSG Checking account must have two signatures. The approved signers of the BLSG checking account for checks in excess of \$500 shall be Ben Lawton (Chairman, Jeff Whiting (Vice-Chairman), Wayne Rausenberger (Teasurer) and Elouise Crane (Bookkeeper).
- 7. Approval of October 8, 2015 minutes
  - After three edits, the minutes were approved (moved: Jeff Whiting, 2<sup>nd</sup>: Wayne Rausenberger)
- 8. Meeting with State Department of Agriculture, Legislators, LFICD and BLSG
  - Ben Lawton reported that this meeting will take place on Tuesday, November 24 in Montpelier from 2:00-4:00 p.m.
  - Ben will attend the meeting, along with Wayne and Will Mathis
